REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF CAMPFIRE CIRCLE AT OAKBOURNE PARK

1. Only normal combustible material (wood and paper) may be used.
2. The use of flammable and/or combustible liquids and gases is **strictly forbidden**.
NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. The use of the campfire (fire circle) is limited to ceremonial use only.
4. The campfire shall not be larger than thirty (30") inches in diameter.
5. Additional material for burning shall be located not less than twenty-five (25') feet from the campfire.
6. Cooking food is **not** permitted, except for roasting marshmallows or popping popcorn.
7. A responsible adult **must be** in attendance at all times during the ceremony.
8. The organization requesting use of the fire circle **must supply** its own fire extinguishing equipment. This equipment must be readily available at all times during the burning of the campfire. This equipment shall be, but not limited to, water and or dry power extinguishers.
9. The campfire shall only be located in the designated area as established by Westtown Township. If another area is requested, it must be approved by the Township Fire Marshal.
10. At the conclusion of the ceremony, the campfire **must be fully extinguished**. All ashes and unburned material must be disposed of properly. The fire pit shall be completely cleaned out and left ready for the next use.
11. Any organization found to be in violation of any of these regulations **will not** be permitted future use of the fire circle. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
