#### EXEMPTIONS

Permit issuance fees and general permit inspection fees are not payable by any of the following:

- 1) The commonwealth
- 2) Political subdivisions of the commonwealth, except when placing a facility longitudinally within more than 100 total linear feet of pavement. In that case, the application and inspection fees for pavement opening will be charged.
- 3) Governmental authorities organized under the laws of the commonwealth
- 4) The federal government
- 5) Charitable organizations that are in compliance with the Institutions of Purely Public Charity Act of 1997 (10 PS 371) (*churches, hospitals, schools, charitable insitutions, veterans' organizations, non-profit orgnizations*)
- 6) Utility facility owners for:
  - a) The installation of street lights at the request of PennDOT or the township.
  - b) The replacement or renewal of their facilities prior of a township resurfacing project, after notice from the township.
  - c) Facilities moved at the request of PennDOT or the township.
  - d) The reconstruction or maintenance of their facilities that occupy the right-of-way under private status.

#### ADDITIONAL INSPECTION FEES

If the township determines that the permitted work is of sufficient magnitude or importance to warrant assignment of one or more persons to inspect the permitted work on a more than spot inspection basis, the permit will so indicate and the permittee will be charged for additional salary, overhead and expenses incurred by each assigned inspector and the township.

## Article I. Excavations

**[Adopted 6-3-1974 by Ord. No. 74-2]**

### § 146-1. Permit required.

In accordance with the provisions of § 1156 of Article XI of the Second Class Township Code, *Editor's Note: Former § 1156 of Article XI of the Second Class Township Code was repealed 11-9-1995 by P.L. 350, No. 60, § 1. See now 53 P.S. § 67322.* as amended, no railroad or street railway shall hereafter be constructed upon any Township road, nor shall any railroad or street railway crossings, nor any gas line, water pipe, electric conduits, or other piping, be laid upon or in, nor shall any telephone, telegraph, or electric light or power poles, or any coal tipples or any other obstructions be erected upon or in, any portion of a Township road except under such conditions, restrictions and regulations relating to the installation and maintenance thereof as may be prescribed by permits granted by the Township for such purpose.

### § 146-2. Permit application.

The application for a permit shall be upon a form prescribed by the Township and submitted to the Township in triplicate. The application shall be accompanied by a fee in accordance with the Schedule of Fees set forth by the Department of Transportation for highway occupancy permits and restoration charges. In addition, the applicant shall submit three copies of a sketch showing such dimensions as the location of the intended facility, width of the traveled roadway, right-of-way lines and a dimension to the nearest intersecting street.

### § 146-3. Issuance of permit.

A permit shall be issued to the applicant after all the aforementioned requirements have been met.

### § 146-4. Notice of completion.

Upon completion of the work, the applicant shall give written notice thereof to the Township.

### **§ 146-5. Inspection; correction of defects; costs.**

Upon completion of the work authorized by the permit, the Township shall inspect the work and, when necessary, enforce compliance with the conditions, restrictions and regulations prescribed by the permit. Where any settlement or defect in the work occurs, if the applicant shall fail to rectify such settlement or other defect, within 60 days after written notice from the Township to do so, the Township may do the work and shall impose upon the applicant the cost thereof, together with an additional 20% of such cost.

### **§ 146-6. Violations and penalties.**

Any person who violates or permits a violation of this article shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding brought before a District Justice under the Pennsylvania Rules of Criminal Procedure, be guilty of a summary offense and shall be punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000, plus costs of prosecution. In default of payment thereof, the defendant may be sentenced to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 90 days. Each day or portion thereof that such violation continues or is permitted to continue shall constitute a separate offense, and each section of this article that is violated shall also constitute a separate offense.

ROAD RESTORATION DETAIL




SUPERPAVE VOLUMETRIC ASPHALT
